

KEELE SURVEY

This parents/carers survey was completed during the second half of the Autumn Term 2008. The questionnaire was sent to a truly random sample of 345 parents/carers. Although only 32% responded, their responses are useful as an indicator of perception and as a pointer towards areas of work which need to be prioritised.

We were delighted by the extremely positive perception parents/carers have of both the school's increasingly good reputation and on the academic and behaviour standards achieved here.

One area we shall continue to address, is the issue of sharing information between school and home. If anybody has any ideas on how we can further improve our practices, we would be pleased to learn of them.

In order that we remain responsive to parent's/carer's views, we have decided to conduct a short survey at each parent/carer consultation evening. The first of these was carried out on Thursday 29th January at the evening for parent's/carer's of Year 10. The responses were again very encouraging and I outline them below.
