

<p>The appeal hearing</p>	<p>For applications made in the normal admissions round, our appeals will be held in two stages:</p> <p><u>Stage 1 – The school’s case</u></p> <p>All parents who have lodged an appeal will be sent a copy of the school’s case with a link to a questionnaire, which will give an opportunity to ask questions.</p> <p>The form must be completed before Thursday 19th May. The Presenting Officer will answer all the questions submitted by the appellants and the panel. The responses will be emailed to all appellants and the panel members.</p> <p>On Monday 23rd May, the panel meet to consider whether the school’s admission arrangements complied with the legal requirements and whether prejudice was proven. If the school’s case is upheld. This decision will be confirmed by email, once received from the Clerk.</p> <p>Provided the independent appeals panel is satisfied that prejudice has been proven, your individual appeal will now take place via Zoom.</p> <p><u>Stage 2 – The parent’s case</u></p> <p>Stage 2 Individual appeal hearings will now take place via a Zoom meeting on Thursday 9th June 2022. Parents will be given the date and time of their individual appeal no less than 10 days before the hearing.</p> <p>If you do not have the access to technology, we can organise for you to attend the school and use a meeting room with access to a laptop. Alternatively, your appeal will be conducted using the written evidence that you have provided. Any further evidence can be submitted by email prior to the appeal.</p>
