Equality Objectives

2021-2022

Our aim at Kimberley School is to enable all students to meet or exceed their academic and social potential. Our equality objectives during 2021-2022 are to:

- Close gaps in attendance between vulnerable groups of students and the rest of the school.
- Implement a remote curriculum so that students who do not attend school for public health reasons are able to continue to access the school curriculum
- During periods of extended enforced restricted school closure:
 - o prioritise the in-school attendance of vulnerable students; or
 - ensure that vulnerable students who do not attend school have access to the technology they need for the remote curriculum and have enhanced support from pastoral teams to ensure they are accessing the remote curriculum.
- During periods of absence for public health reasons:
 - Ensure that vulnerable students have access to the technology they need for the remote curriculum; and
 - have enhanced support from pastoral teams to ensure they are accessing the remote curriculum
- Use Catch Up Funding and the 16-19 Tuition Fund to target additional support to tackle gaps in knowledge, skills and understanding in individual or groups of students.
- Ensure that curriculum and teaching is ambitious for students who have lower prior attainment or have a special educational need or disability.
